Implementation of the SEE URBAN project was initiated in January 2017 and will last until December 2018.

The project primarily targets local level Disaster Management Authorities in South East Europe, aiming to formalize local level cooperation in urban DRR (both at city / municipality level and cross-border / regional level). In doing so, project is to, inter alia, develop SEE URBAN electronic DRR library and strengthen local level DRR practitioners' knowledge on urban risks. Besides that, public awareness campaigns on urban DRR risks will be implemented which will be beneficial for citizens and all other socio-economic sectors vulnerable to urban disasters. Finally, as the work of "local level DRR platforms" is to feed into national DRR platforms, a network of urban local level DRR stakeholders will be formed at the regional level of South East Europe.
